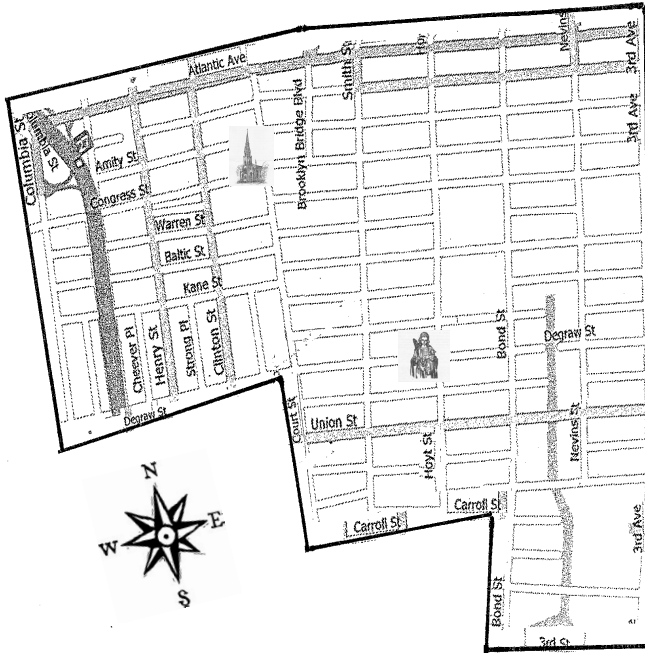

This Mass of Thanksgiving is offered for Sister's 70 years of commitment to religious life and devoted parochial service. 50 of the last 70 years she has served in our neighborhood in the parishes of

- St. Peter-Our Lady of Pilar (1961-1975)
- St. Peter's-St. Paul's-Our Lady of Pilar (1975-2007);
- St. Paul & St. Agnes (2007 to the present).

Sister Innocentia was born in her family's home at 36 1st Place in Red Hook (now Carroll Gardens) and grew up in St. Stephen's Parish (now Sacred Hearts-St. Stephen). She entered the Missionary Sisters of the Most Blessed Trinity in 1941. After her novitiate, from 1942 to 1961, Sister worked in parishes in West Orange, NJ; Cambridge, MA; Ensley, AL; and Patterson, NJ.
