



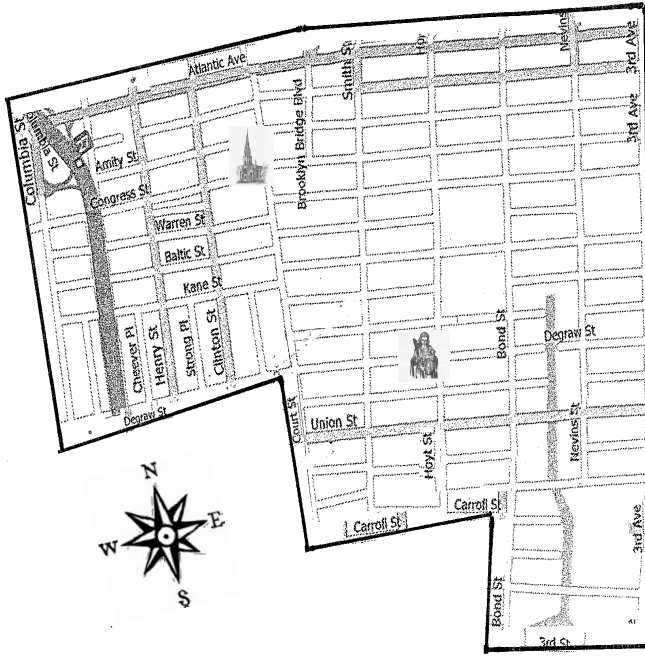

The Ten Commandments Pamphlet

"The Ten Commandments" was first published in 1971 with the imprimatur of the first Bishop of Rockville Centre, LI, the late Bishop Walter Kellenberg. I received a copy of the pamphlet that year, when I was a sixth grader at St. Mary's School in Manhasset.

I think that this little pamphlet completely captures the spirit of the renewal of Vatican II that concluded only 6 years before its publication with regard to the Council's emphasis on the importance of conscience, stressing both the importance of respect for the objective moral laws of the Church that are inspired by the Holy Spirit and the importance of the individual response to the voice of the Holy Spirit in the living out of the commandments. This pamphlet describes first what positive behavior each commandment demands of us before listing what behavior it forbids. But the effect of the pamphlet's content is not to oversimplify what adherence to the Ten Commandments means; rather it is to inspire a search to know the will of God in one's own life.
