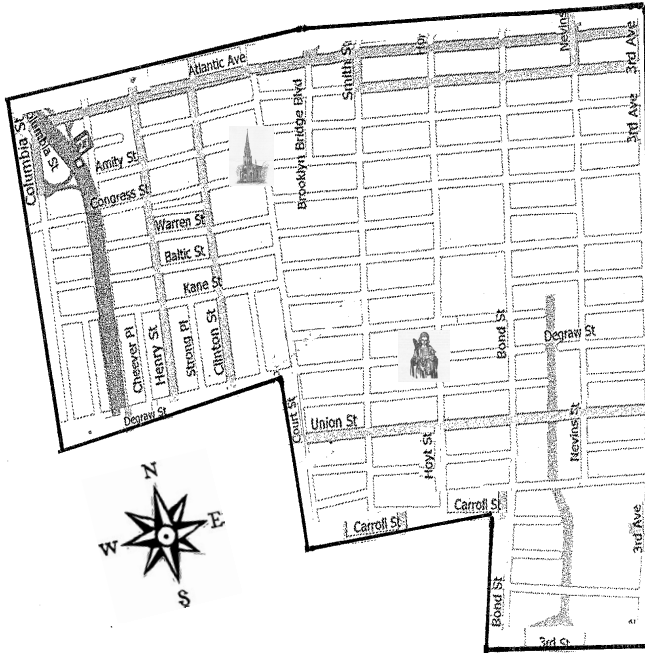

Tours of Inisfada

Inisfada (Irish for Long Island) was originally the mansion of 87 rooms & 37 chimneys and the 300 acre estate of Nicholas Brady and his wife, Genevieve, who became a papal duchess. Built in 1919, the mansion's style is Jacobean Revival and Tudor-Elizabethan. Particularly remarkable for its intricate wood carvings is Duchess Brady's private chapel, St. Genevieve's. Angelo Cardinal Pacelli, who later became Pope Pius XII (1939-1958), was a guest at Inisfada in the early 1930's. In 1937, Mrs. Brady gave Inisfada to the Society of Jesus (the Jesuits) who have maintained it as St. Ignatius Retreat House ever since.

Tours of Inisfada are \$10 per person and can be arranged by contacting Fr. Damian Halligan, SJ at 516 621 8300 ext. 24. Inisfada is about a 45 minute drive from our parish & is located at 251 Searingtown Road, Manhasset, LI 11030 (Exit 36 on the LIE). A virtual tour is available at www.inisfada.net.
