



COMING UP AT SPSA: Sunday PreK & K Religious Ed

meets again on Sun., Jan. 8th, and many Sun. mornings at St .Agnes Center at 10 AM. No registration or regular attendance required. All infants, pre-K, & kindergarten children & their parents are welcome. These years of a child's life are fertile ground for catechesis. This program, now in its 2nd year, has been lifegiving for all who have participated in it.

Getting Used to the New Translation

I strongly recommend all parishioners do the following in order to participate fully at Mass:

Use a missalette for the readings and Eucharistic prayer. The translation of the Scriptures remains the same, but you might discover reading along with the proclamation enables you to focus better. Silently reading the Eucharistic prayer with the celebrant will enable you to better focus upon and pray the prayer. No missalette should be removed from the church.

Use a pew card for the new responses. Pew cards with the newly translated responses of the congregation means you can avoid much flipping through the missalette, particularly during the Introductory Rites of the Mass. You could then use the missalette only for the readings and for the Eucharistic prayer.

To obtain a pew card is quite easy: simply visit the Parish Office during office hours, or call either office and and leave a message with your name and address, or email your request to stpaulstagnes@gmail.com.

Christmas Food Vouchers

Envelopes are available for parishioners who wish to provide food vouchers for many unemployed and low income people who live within the boundaries of our parish. These vouchers are redeemable for \$50 from worth of food ítems at MetFood on Smith Street. 49 vouchers were given out before Thanksgiving; \$2450 was taken from the St. Vincent de Paul Fund to pay for the vouchers. Another \$2450 in vouchers was given out this past week; a full report will appear in next week's bulletin.

Pray for Your Family at Mass in SPSA Next Sunday 01/01

As we have done in past years in SPSA on the Sunday in the Octave of Christmas, next Sunday, January 1st, we will invite all members of the congregation to enter into the sanctuary, place their hands upon the altar, and pray for their family members, living and deceased.

Usually the Sunday in the octave is the Solemnity of the Holy Family, but this year it has been superceded by Mary, Mother of God, which is always observed on Jan. 1st. Nevertheless, the focus on the family is appropriate on this feast as well. What St. Luke says of Mary at the time of the birth of Jesus is that "she kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart."

Just as Mary reflected upon God's mysterious presence in her family, so we must do with God's presence in our families, praying for our family members and asking God to give us the grace to understand and love them as He does.
