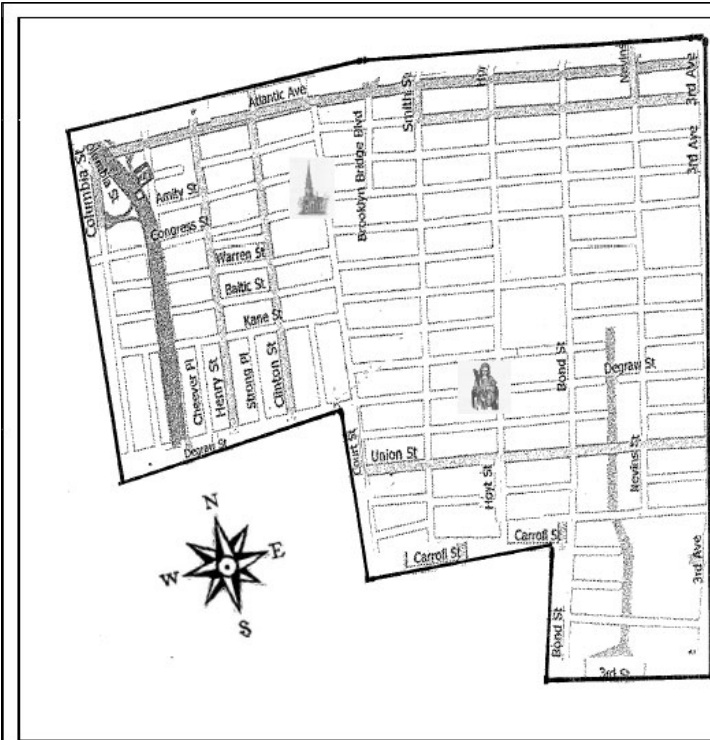

THIS WEEK AT SPSA:

Response to Maryknoll Mission Appeal Rises to 47% on Sun., July 7th

Thank you to the 141 parish households who have returned
their Maryknoll Mission Appeal envelopes. Many of those who
gave generously; the average gift was \$17. Forty-nine
(49) envelopes have been returned at **St. Agnes** so far, with a
total of **\$819**. Ninety-two (92) envelopes have been returned
at **St. Paul's** so far, with a total of **\$1681**. While **141** envelopes
were returned in the parish with a total of **\$2500**, 500 people
from 300 parish households attended Mass in our two church-
es on June 8 & 9 when the Maryknoll priests spoke. More than
53 % of our parish households (about 160) did not return a
Maryknoll Mission Appeal envelope as of Sun., July 7.

Support of the missionary arm of the Church is obligatory
for all Catholics, both by finances and by prayer. **Envelopes
with green dots are available by the church entrances. Please
return your envelope in the collection on July 20 & 21.** This
American congregation of brothers and priests works with the
poorest peoples on our planet; they deserve our support.
