



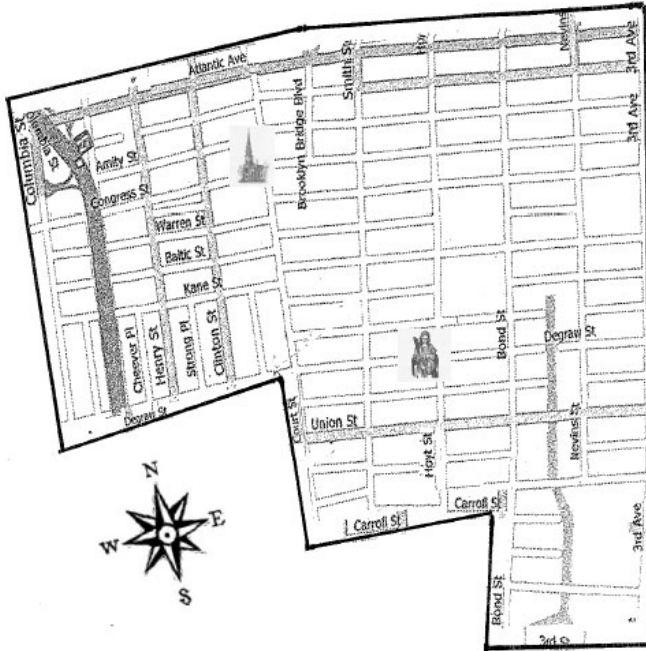

THIS WEEK AT SPSA:

Response to Maryknoll Mission Appeal at 44% as of Sun., June 30

Thank you to the 131 parish households who have returned
their Maryknoll Mission Appeal envelopes. Many of those who
gave generously; the average gift was \$18. Forty-six (46)
envelopes have been returned at **St. Agnes** so far, with a total
of **\$801**. Eighty-five (85) envelopes have been returned at **St.
Paul's** so far, with a total of **\$1537**. While **131** envelopes were
returned in the parish with a total of **\$2338**, 500 people from
300 parish households attended Mass in our two churches on
June 8 & 9 when the Maryknollers spoke. More than 55 % of
our parish households (almost 170) did not return a Maryknoll
Mission Appeal envelope as of last Sun., June 30.

Support of the missionary arm of the Church is obligatory
for all Catholics, both by finances and by prayer. **Envelopes
with green dots are available by the church entrances. Please
return your envelope in the collection on July 13 & 14.** This
American congregation of brothers and priests works with the
poorest peoples on our planet; they deserve our support.
