LENTEN REMINDERS

Abstinence— All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain totally from meat all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting— All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions during the day.

Easter Duty— After they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time of the year. By special indult, in the United States, the time period for fulfilling this precept has been extended to include the period beginning the First Sunday of Lent -Feb. 22, 2015 to Trinity Sunday-May 31, 2015.

EN ESPANOL

Abstinencia – todos los fieles que han llegado a 14 años de edad están requeridos a abstenerse totalmente de carne todos los viernes de Cuaresma.

Ayuno – todos los fieles entre las edades de 18 y 59 incluido están obligados a ayunar en miércoles de ceniza y viernes santo. Esta práctica consiste en uno mismo limitarse a una sola comida completa y evitando alimentos entre comidas. Pequeños sustento puede tomarse también en otras dos ocasiones durante el día.

Deber Pascual – después de que han sido iniciados en la Santísima Eucaristía, todos los fieles están sujetos a la obligación de recibir la Santa Comunión por lo menos una vez al año. Este precepto debe cumplirse durante el tiempo Pascual, a no ser por una buena razón se satisface en otro tiempo del año. Por indulto especial, en los Estados Unidos, el tiempo para cumplir con este precepto se ha ampliado para incluir el período que comienza el primer domingo de Cuaresma (22 de febrero de 2015) al domingo de la Trinidad (31 de mayo de 2015).

VIA CRUCES

Durante la Cuaresma tendremos la vía cruces en Sta. Inés, los miércoles después de la misa de las 8:30 am y en San. Pablo los viernes después de la misa de las 8:30 am. **Los Viernes** por la noche a las **7pm en La Iglesia de San Pablo.**
